These empanelment's are subject to following conditions-

- 1. Empanelment are governed by the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987, RSLSA Rules of 1995, RSLSA Regulations of 1999, NALSA (Free & Competent Legal Services) Regulations, 2010 (as amended), NALSA Legal Aid Clinics Scheme, Front Office Scheme and other directions and schemes issued from time to time.
- 2. Present empanelment is for a period of ONE YEAR (upto31st October, 2020) commencing from the date of empanelment, but shall be subject to review of performance/ work done by each lawyer appointed by this authority for each DLSA/ TLSC and may be extended further two years (Maximum one year at single instance)
- 3. These engagement of panel lawyers on their own request with an object to provide access to justice to needy, poor and downtrodden for legal aid activities including engagement as legal aid counsel, legal advice on case to case basis or monthly retainer basis, participation in legal awareness programmes, as a member of bench of lok adalat and member under various schemes or any other type of services in furtherance of object of Legal Services Authority.
- 4. All advocates empanelled herein are engaged on cases to cases basis and programme/ scheme basis, and they are entitled to receive honorarium/ compensation according to guidelines of RSLSA,
- 5. Legal aid cases would be allotted according to seniority and on rotation basis but an endeavour shall be made to allot cases according to their expertise or area of practice. It shall be duty of every panel lawyer to faithfully discharge duty towards the Legal aid recipient and dereliction from duty shall be a ground to remove not only from the case in hand but also from the panel.
- 6. It shall be duty of every Panel Advocate to submit report promptly to DLSA/TLSC regarding the work assigned to him.
- 7. There would be daily updation procedure for legal aid cases and legal aid lawyers has to submit progress report of case in order to ensure effective Monitoring.
- 8. All empanelled Advocates are refrained from using the proclamation that RSLSA or DLSA or any complainant referred to them is one of his/her Client.
- 9. All empanelled Advocates are required to attend training programmes and other courses organized by RSLSA or DLSA or other organization under aegis of RSLSA to enable empanelled Advocates to upgrade skills and develop awareness about legal services programme. It shall be duty and endeavour of every panel lawyer to attend Legal Awareness Camps or Mega Legal services camp organized under the aegis of RSLSA or DLSA.

- 10. Observance of Moral and Ethics: It shall be duty of every panel advocate to maintain confidentiality of legal aid recipient and serve him with best of his ability. The panel advocates are entitled to get honorarium or compensation from DLSA or TLSC but they are not entitled to charge or demand any kind or favour or cash from any Legal service recipient. In case of any complaint or violation, in either manner reported or found apart from removal from panel other actions including intimation to the Bar council may also be affected.
- 11. Removal from Panel: If the performance of Advocate is found unsatisfactory or the Advocate is found to be guilty miss conduct in any form or found guilty of violating the principles of the LSA Act, Rules and Regulations, he/she can be removed from the panel.
- 12. The Authority reserves its rights to enlarge the scope of the duty of such empanelled Advocates in order to achieve the aim and object of The Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 and its Rules, Regulations and other schemes formed there under.
